

Oxfordshire Wheels for All Junior Cycle fleet

Below are pictures of the cycles which are currently available at the junior session in Witney along with descriptions.

This has been created to help parents / carers and participants identify which cycles will be most suitable to meeting their needs prior to a session.

Velo Plus

The Velo Plus has revolutionised wheelchair cycling and makes every session all inclusive. It has hydraulic brakes/gears and handles extremely well. It has a weight allowance that will enable even the biggest electric wheelchair to be transported.



Tri- cycles

Below are photos of the trikes which are part of the fleet. We have a range of trikes meeting the needs of 3 year olds plus who take part in the sessions, in addition to the small red trike in the picture there is also one available in maroon.



Excellerator handcycle

We have two Excellerator hand cycles as part of the Junior Wheels for All fleet giving people across the junior age range with limited lower body movement access to cycling. The hand cycles are proving to be very popular because people haven't tried them before, different muscle groups are worked compared with the ones used on a conventional cycle.



KMX go carts

Like the Excellerator hand cycles we also have two KMX go cart style cycles again giving people across the junior age range access to this form of cycling. As you will see from the photo the cycling takes place in a reclined position and is proving to be fun and popular. One of the main reason for its popularity again being that people haven't taken part in this form of cycling before.





Two wheeled cycles

We also have a range of two wheeled cycles which are suitable for participants. This starts off with a balance bike for young people at the lower end of the Wheels for All junior age range (directly below) then bikes for older girls and boys.
